



# Do you want to earn college credit during your senior year?

If you do, then you need to sign up for **English IV: College Now** during registration this spring.

**What is College Now?** College Now is a course run through Wharton County Junior College (course 1301 and 1302) taught at AHS. You will receive college credit, and the credits you need for graduation.

**English 1301:** Study of English to improve students' ability to think objectively and to communicate effectively. Stress on clarity and effectiveness in the sentence, paragraph, and whole composition. The composition is chiefly expository, and assigned material is designed to increase students' ability to read objectively, to develop skills in critical analysis, and to improve their style. Prerequisites: THEA reading and writing requirements met.

**English 1302:** Second half of the English composition sequence. Emphasizes the process of writing a research paper and analysis and interpretation of printed material. Students are encouraged to read with a degree of sophistication and to apply the principles of critical thinking and organization to written assignments. Prerequisites: ENGL 1301

**How do I sign up for it?** You will register through Wharton County Junior College and your counselor when you register for classes. There will be some paperwork to fill out, and you will have to send your transcripts to WCJC when you register.

**How much does it cost?** College Now cost 360\$ a semester. (subject to change)

**Will the credits transfer over to the colleges I attend?** Yes, to all public colleges in Texas.
